



The sealed tender must be super scribed “**N.I.T.& Sl.No., Name of the work , Name & address of Tenderer**” Telegraphic Tenders will not be entertained. Tenders received late on account of any reasons whatsoever will be returned to the Tenderer unopened.
3. Complete set of Tender documents issued to the Tenderer(s) must be submitted duly filled in by ink & duly signed by the Tenderer at the bottom of each page while dropping the Tender . otherwise the tender will be treated as informal.
4. If the tender is made by an individual, it shall be signed by individual above his full name and current Address.
5. If the tender is made by a proprietary firm, it shall be signed by the proprietor above his full name and full name his firm with current address.
6. All signatures in the tender document shall be dated.
7. Rate quoted in the tender shall be fixed during the period of contract and shall not be subjected to any variation on any grounds. Conditional tender will not be entertained.


