1. INVITATION :

Sealed tender in two bid system is invited by the C.M.O.H. , BANKURA from bonafide contractors having ability & sufficient experience in civil work.

On all working days from 27/06/2011 to 28/06/2011 from 11.00hrs. to 14.30 hrs. **No tender paper shall be issued by post**

(iii) Receipt of Tenders.

Sealed tender will be received upto 14.00hrs. on 30/06/2011 in the Tender Box kept for the purpose at the office of the C.M.O.H., Bankura.

(iv) Opening of Tenders.

Tender will be opened by the C.M.O.H., Bankura or his authorized representative at the office of the former at 15.00hrs. on 30/06/2011 in presence of intending Tenderer /their authorized representative.

If the date of opening of the tender be declared as holiday or office remains closed due to administrative reasons or any other reasons what so ever , the tender will be opened on the next working day at the same venue & same time. Other condition will remain same.

- E. Language of Tender : The tenders shall be submitted in the prescribed form in English. All literatures and correspondence in connection with the contract shall be in English.
- F. Tender Validity : The tender shall be valid up to 90 days from the date of acceptance of the tender.
- G. Earnest Money Deposit: An amount as shown in above chart for each work shall have to be paid by Demand Draft and in favour of "**District Health & Family Welfare Samity, C.M.O.H. Office , Bankura**", payable at Bankura. N.S.C/K.V.P. will not be accepted.
Tenders without Earnest Money will be rejected.

2. All intending tenderes shall have to submitted with the tender up to date :

- E) PAN No
- F) Payment Certificate/Completion certificate of similar type of work value as mentioned above under Govt. Or Public Sector issued by the EIC/Appropriate. Authority
- G) All other documents as per clauses of tender documents

In this **Two Bid** system the Tenderer must submit two separate sealed envelopes marked Technical Bid and Price Bid. In the first cover must contain the documents regarding his eligibility as prescribed above with duly attested copies of payment & completion certificate & S.T. Registration certificate & the requisite earnest money in proper form super scribing on the

envelop qualifying documents mentioning the N.I.T. No., SL.No & Name of Work as **Technical Bid** . In the other sealed cover quoting the rate in overall percentage basis i.e. above/below/at per rate in W.B. Form No- 2911(ii) & enclosed schedule of rates & other remaining documents superscribing the envelop as **Price Bid** with the N.I.T. No. , SL.No. & Name of Work.

3. The contractor should quote the rate AT PAR/BELOW/ABOVE the schedule of rate on percentage basis which will be attached with the tender documents. The rate in figures as well in as words should be mentioned. In this case of conflict between the words , the letter one will prevail.

4. Successful tenderers shall have to execute agreement in triplicate on cash payment of Rs 200 per set (non-refundable) with the B.M.O.H within 7(seven) days from the date of issue of acceptance letter of tender after depositing an amount equivalent to 2% (two percent) value of the work as security for performance in Favour of B.M.O.H. and balance 8% value of work will be deducted from the progressive bill thus making a total 10% (ten percent) of security for performance. Failure to execute the agreement within the time frame may lead to forfeiture of earnest money and emolument of tender. After successful execution of agreement by the concerned B.M.O.H formal work order will be issued.

5. The C.M.O.H. reserves the right to reject the lowest tender or all the tenders without assigning any reasons whatsoever and may split up the work if necessary and to accept any tender in whole or in part. The C.M.O.H. is not to bound to accept the lowest tender also.

6. The C.M.O.H., Bankura is the tender accepting authority.

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITION

The following special terms & conditions shall constitute a part of the contract & shall be binding on the tenderers .

1. The tender shall be submitted in prescribed form in English. All the literature & correspondences in connection with the contract shall be in English
2. The Tenders must be submitted in sealed cover. The sealed tender must be super scribed "**N.I.T.& Sl.No., Name of the work , Name & address of Tenderer**" Telegraphic Tenders will not be entertained. Tenders recived late on account of any reasons whatsoever will be returned to the Tenderer unopened.
3. Complete set of Tender documents issued to the Tenderer(s) must be submitted duly filled in by ink & duly signed by the Tenderer at the bottom of each page while dropping the Tender , otherwise the tender will be treated as informal.
4. If the tender is made by an individual, it shall be signed by individual above his full name and present Address.
5. If the tender is made by a proprietary firm, it shall be signed by the proprietor above his full name and full name of his firm with present address.
6. All signatures in the tender document shall be dated.
7. Rate quoted in the tender shall be fixed during the period of contract and shall not be subjected to any variation on any grounds. Conditional tender will not be entertained.
8. The Tenderer shall be entirely responsible for the sufficiency of rates quoted by him / them in his / their tenders.
9. Tender shall be valid for a period of not less than 90 (Ninety) days from the date of opening of Tender. Tenders once submitted shall not be withdrawn within the validity period. The Tender inviting authority may request for extension of the Tender validity period.
10. In case of unsuccessful tenderers, the earnest money will be released after finalisation of the tender. In case of successful tenderer, the earnest money will be realeased after completion of agreement by depositing security .
11. The specifications of works, mode of execution & measurement will be governed by the specification laid down in PWD Schedule of rates and relevant provision of I.S. Code & as per direction of Engineer in Charge.
12. The work shall be carried out strictly according to the schedule of work & technical specification & drawing.
13. Tenderers should inspect at their own cost the site and acquaint themselves with difficulties and peculiarities if any prevailing at sites and quote the rate accordingly.
14. Rate shall be inclusive of all incidental charges & fees i.e. Royalties, Tax on materials, Electricity & other charges of Municipality / Statutory bodies Sales Tax, Income Tax etc. inclusive of all necessary expenditure covering all incidental factors like location, site condition. Approachability of the site etc. & no extra claim on any of this account will be entertained.
15. No claim for idle labour will be entertained under any circumstances.

16. Water for construction purpose, drinking water for use by the labours & others at site shall have to be arranged by the Agency at his own cost & no claim on this account will be entertained.
17. All provisions of labour laws including any amendment shall be followed strictly by the Agency. No child labour shall be engaged. Proper working condition for the labour shall be maintained & minimum stipulated facilities to the labourers shall be arranged by the Agency. Local labours shall be engaged & minimum wages shall be paid to them accordingly.
18. No Departmental materials like Cement / Steel will be supplied. Cement & other materials shall be procured by the Agency & should have got approved by the Engineer-In-Charge before use for the work, Rejected materials, if any shall be cleared from site within 48 (Forty-eight) hours of rejection.
19. Any loss or damage of manpower and / or materials either at the time of execution of work at site or during the period of work shall be the responsibility of the agency.
20. No claim shall be entertained or no benefit shall be arrived at out of any typographical, arithmetical or clerical mistakes in the schedule of work etc.
21. The Agency shall make their own arrangement for storage of materials at site for their tools & plants etc.
22. The Agency shall remove all the unserviceable materials from the site after completion of the work the rubbishes etc. & shall dress & level the work site at their own cost as per direction of EIC.
23. Canvassing in connection with the tender process shall be strictly prohibited.
24. If any case, testing of materials is required, the cost of testing will have to be borne by the agency.
25. Tender from will not be issued to the agencies who have not dropped the tender paper even after issuance of tender form against previous N.I.T. under this division.
26. If any defect is found after the completion the work agency will bound to rectify it at his own cost within the period of security. Otherwise department will rectify it with the help of other agency or departmentally and its cost will be deducted from the security deposit.
27. The work have to be started within 7(seven) days of the date of issue of work order and to be completed within the stipulated period mentioned in the contract.
