T E N D E R N O T I C E

As per letter of Joint Secretary and Additional Mission Director (NRHM) vide Memo No. HFW/NRHM-65/2010/836 dated 28th April, 2011 the under signed invites sealed tenders from the intending owners of the commercial diesel car preferably Ambulance for 24 X 7 hours services for implementation of "Nischay Yan Prokalpa" throughout the district. The eligible interested owners may submit sealed tender with all attested necessary papers in the office of the undersigned.

Necessary tender forms, notification are available in free of cost by showing the Blue book of the Ambulance/Car at the all BPHCs, RHs as well as office of the CMOH, Bankura from 17th to 19th May, 2011 between 11.00am to 2.00pm. Tenderers may drop their tenders to the CMOH office on 01st June, 2011 between 11.00am to 1.00pm and it will be opened on the same day at 2.00pm. Tenderers may appear themselves or their authorized representative during opening and selection of the tenders.

1. General Information:-

- 31 No. of Diesel/LPG/CNG commercial Ambulance/Car will be selected for different Health Institutions of this district (2 Ambulance/Car each for DH-1 & SDH-2 and 1 Ambulance/Car each for BPHC-17, RH-5 & PHC-3)
- Fuel (Diesel/LPG/CNG) will be allowed 1 liter/12KM for Motor cab & 10 KM for Maxi Cab in addition to Mobil oil @ 1 liter for 500 Km. run for all categories of vehicle.
- Health Institution will allow to stay the driver only within the campus.
- Tender will be entertained in the specified format only.
- The **daily rate** would be clearly mentioned in the tender form by the Owners/bidders which should be sealed properly.
- Selection will be done as per lowest rate & latest model and final decision would be taken by the selection committee.
- The CMOH will have all the right to select or cancel any participant/s in the tender process without any notice or information.
- Owners/bidders will not have any right to ask any clarification regarding selection or cancellation if any.
- The any owner/bidder is unable to submit necessary papers that the tender will be rejected by the CMOH, Bankura.
- All selected Ambulance/Car for the aforesaid exclusive purpose should display the name "Matriyan" and toll-free telephone No. "102" for booking these vehicles, on the external surface of both sides of the vehicle along with the logo of NRHM.


Eligibility Criteria for participation in the tender:

- Only the owner of the Diesel/LPG/CNG commercial Ambulance/Car is eligible to drop the tender. The Government ambulance, PPP ambulance and those acquired from MP or MLA LAD fund will not be considered.
- All the necessary documents i.e. Receipt of Purchased Ambulance/Car, Blue book (Commercial No.), Pollution Certificate, Fitness certificate, Driving license etc. of the Ambulance/Car should have updated.

- Date of purchased of Ambulance/Car should be after 01.05.2005.If it is not available other commercial diesel vehicles may be considered by the selection committee as per the condition of vehicle/s.

3. Condition of Tender:-

- Tender should filled up in the specified formate only.
- Attested xerox copies of all sorts of papers should be enclosed with the tender.
- No charge will be paid to the vehicle or levy penalty imposed if the vehicle withdrawn or any reason what so ever and replacement not arranged thereto.
- Tenderer would arrange replacement of the Driver in case of his absence for duty forth with.
- Absence of Ambulance- service from 24 hrs. service for the stipulated Institution for any reason what so ever could not be accepted.
- An **Earnest Money** through a Bank draft of Rs.5000/- for each Ambulance in favour of the Chief Medical Officer of Health, Bankura is to be enclosed with the tender in absence of which the tender would be treated as cancelled. The drafts of the un-successful tender could be released subsequently.
- Income tax, sales tax, professional tax clearances certificates of the tenderer must be enclosed with the tender.
- The earnest money so deposited by the tender could be forfeited in case of the selected tenderer fails to execute the work order in whole or any part thereby. The C.M.O.H., Bankura reserve the right to forfeite the earnest money of the selected tenderer if any mal practice noticed by him which is going against the interest of the Govt.
- The selected tenderers should come with an agreement with the CMOH, Bankura to place the vehicles at the specified Hospitals. If the tenderer fails to sign the agreement in time of start execution of the work order, the work order would be treated as cancelled and earnest money deposit would be forfeited.
- Security deposit amounting to Rs.10,000/- will have to be deposited by the successful tenderer in form of NSC/KVP duty pledged in favour of CMOH, Bankura. The security deposit would, however, be released after satisfactory completion of tenure of supply by the tenderer to fulfillment of the contract.
- Contract would be made for **ten months** for the present.
- CMOH, Bankura reserve the right to accept or reject the lowest or any other tenders without assigning any reason there off.
